

## Adult Day Scholarship Program

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### Support for Family Caregivers

The Memory Connection provides respite scholarships to family caregivers whose loved ones are living with Alzheimer's disease or other dementias. These scholarships cover the cost of an approved, licensed Adult Day Program, giving you time to rest, recharge, and care for yourself, while your loved one enjoys a safe and engaging environment.

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### Am I Eligible?

You must be able to answer **YES** to each of the following:

- My loved one has been professionally diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease or another dementia.
  - My loved one is currently living at home with me.
  - I am experiencing financial and/or emotional strain due to caregiving.
  - I reside in the United States.
  - If I've applied before, at least 3 months have passed since my last application.
  - I have received no more than 2 scholarships in the past 12 months.
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### How It Works

- **Apply once per quarter** (one application per caregiver).
  - Applications are **reviewed monthly**.
  - You will be notified by email within **30–60 days**.
  - Scholarships provide **non-medical social support services** at a licensed Adult Day Program and have **no cash value**.
  - Recipients choose their own Adult Day Program provider.
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### Guidelines

- Maximum of **two (2)** scholarships per caregiver within a 12-month period.
- After two awards, caregivers may reapply **12 months from the start date of the first scholarship awarded**.
- Reapplying does not guarantee a new award or the same level of support.
