



Adult Day Scholarship Application

Am I Eligible to Apply?

To qualify for a Adult Day Scholarship from **The Memory Connection**, you must be able to answer **YES** to each of the following:

1. Has your loved one been professionally diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease or another form of dementia?
 2. Is your loved one currently living at home with you?
 3. Are you experiencing financial and/or emotional strain due to the challenges of caregiving?
 4. Do you reside in the United States?
 5. If you previously applied but were not awarded, has at least three months passed since your last application?
 6. If you have received a scholarship in the past, have you remained within the limit of no more than two awards within a 12-month period?

Wonderful! The Memory Connection Adult Day Scholarship is designed to give caregivers the opportunity to take a well-deserved break while knowing their loved one is receiving safe, engaging, and professional care.

Scholarship funds cover the cost of an approved, licensed Adult Day Program, giving you time to rest, recharge, and care for yourself, while your loved one enjoys a safe and engaging environment.

Guidelines & Application Process

The Memory Connection

The Memory Connection provides respite scholarships to family caregivers whose loved ones are living with Alzheimer's disease or other dementias. While a cure for Alzheimer's remains elusive, compassionate care is only one conversation away. Our mission is to offer families support, rest, and relief.

Scholarship Details

- Scholarships cover **Adult Day Program care only; no cash value.**

- Recipients choose their preferred Adult Day Program provider.
- Only **one application per caregiver** will be accepted each quarter.

Review Process

- The Application Review Committee reviews submissions monthly.
- Applicants will be notified of their status within **30–60 days** of submission.

Completing Your Application

Please share a detailed narrative of your caregiving experience and current circumstances. One- or two-sentence answers may not give the committee sufficient context, which could limit your chances. The deeper the detail you provide, the better we can understand your story.

Before submitting, double-check your responses for accuracy.

Notification of Status

All updates will be sent by email. To ensure you receive them, please add info@thememoryconnection.org to your contact list. If no updates arrive, check your spam, junk, or clutter folder.

If someone is assisting the caregiver with the application, please use the caregiver's own email address for registration so they receive all communications directly.

Additional Guidelines

1. A maximum of **two (2)** scholarships may be awarded per caregiver within a 12-month period.
2. After two awards, caregivers may reapply **12 months from the start date of the first scholarship awarded**.
3. Reapplying does not guarantee a new award or the same level of support received previously.
